

SFACEF Scholarship 2015 Requirements & Criteria

Presentation Date: October 3, 2015



Purpose:

- To award a scholarship to a deserving 2015 secondary graduate planning to complete a college program.

Eligibility:

- The student should have a connection to the Filipino-American community of Brevard County, Florida.
- He or she must have graduated secondary education during the school year 2014-2015.

Application Requirements:

- Complete the [scholarship application form](#).
- Submit transcript and SAT score documentation.
- Submit two letters of recommendation from persons associated with applicant's extracurricular and community services.
- There is currently a bill before the U.S. House and Senate proposing to award the Congressional Gold Medal to Filipino Veterans of World War II. In light of this, write and submit an essay of at least two hundred (200) words on the subject:

What the Sacrifices Made by Filipino Veterans Means to Me

Selection Criteria:

- Grade Point Average
- Scholastic Aptitude Test score
- Extracurricular Activities (school, workplace, church, etc.)
- Community Involvement
- Essay

Judging:

The Scholarship Awards Committee will submit their final decision to the Board of Trustees of Florida's Space Coast Filipino-American Charitable and Educational Foundation, Inc. (Florida's SFACEF Inc.) for presenting at a ceremony on October 03, 2015 at the Eau Gallie Civic Center, Melbourne, Florida.
